3. The Defendant shall file and serve any detailed grounds for contesting the claim and any written

evidence or documents not already filed, in a paginated and indexed bundle, by 4pm on 16 May

2023.

4. Any application by the Claimants to lodge evidence in reply must be filed and served by 4pm

on 6 June 2023.

5. The Claimants must file an agreed hearing bundle no less than 28 days before the substantive

hearing.

6. The Claimants must file and serve a skeleton argument no less than 21 days before the

substantive hearing.

7. The Defendant must file and serve a skeleton argument no less than 14 days before the

substantive hearing.

8. The Claimants must file an agreed bundle of authorities no less than 7 days before the

substantive hearing.

9. The substantive hearing shall be listed for 2 days before a High Court Judge. The parties shall

inform the Court if the time estimate changes following service of the Defendant's detailed

grounds.

10. Costs in the case.
